The fee and deposit are due at the time of the party registration.

Please check in at the Welcome Center the day of your party.

- The party includes tables and party space in the corridor, plus use of the family pool for up to 15 swimmers for 3 hours.
- There is a \$50 cleaning deposit, which will be returned as long as the party is cleaned up afterwards.
 - Cash deposits will be returned via check, and credit payments will be refunded to your account within 5 - 7 days.
 - Check deposits will be given back the day of the party.
- Member rate: \$95 - plus \$3.00 for each additional swimmer
- Non-Member Rate: \$145 - plus \$3.50 for each additional swimmer

YMCA Facility Usage Policies and Agreement:

1. Proper clean-up of the facility is required. Please wipe down party tables, dispose of trash, sweep, etc.
2. Food and drinks may be consumed in the hallway or lobby only. No food or drink is allowed in the pool area.
3. While in the facility, children 10 years of age or younger should be under direct supervision of an adult. The only exception to this is if the child is enrolled in a YMCA supervised program.
4. Shirts and shoes are required in the Y facility unless otherwise noted. Please dry off and wear shoes when re-entering the lobby from the pool area.
5. Anyone doing physical damage to the facility or its furnishings will be held financially responsible. All such incidents will be documented on a Y incident report.
6. Any injury occurring on Y property shall be reported immediately to a staff member and documented on a Y incident report. The YMCA does not carry accident or health insurance on members or users of the facility.
7. In the event of an alarm (fire or emergency), evacuate the building in an orderly fashion. All emergency exits are clearly marked.
8. No illegal drugs or alcoholic beverages are permitted on Y property.
9. In consideration of the health and comfort of our members, tobacco use is not permitted anywhere on the Y property. The Y is a smoke-free and drug free environment.
10. Y use can be terminated upon staff recommendation

The YMCA reserves the right to refuse service to anyone or group if deemed they are in violation of our policies.

Aquatics Center Rules

Pool Rules

1. Obey lifeguard at all times
2. Members and guests age 13 and under must pass a swim test OR be within 3 feet of an adult in the water to be in the lap pool or beyond the blue and white rope in the family pool.
3. Children age 4 and under must be within arm's reach (3 feet) of a responsible person age 14 or over in the water at all times. initial_____
4. Children aged 5-10 must have a responsible adult on the pool deck with them at all times. If unable to pass the swim test, they must remain in a depth no greater than their chest.
5. Appropriate swim attire must be worn. Street clothes or underwear are not permitted in place of a swimsuit. Children not yet potty trained must wear a swim diaper.
6. NO DIVING! NO FLIPS! NO EXCEPTIONS!
7. Inflatable water wings, infant rings or other inflatable floatation are not permitted.
8. No extended underwater breath holding activities
9. No abusive or foul language, excessive displays of affection or lewd behavior
10. No rough housing, horseplay or holding on to another person. Parents with small children are ok.
11. Please walk on the pool deck
12. No food or beverages. No glass containers. No alcohol.

Slide Rules

1. Obey the lifeguard at all times.
2. Must be at least 48" tall to ride.
3. Single riders only. No children on laps.
4. Goggles or glasses may not be worn.
5. No life vests on the slides.
6. Seated or lying on the back, feet first only.
7. Exit the slide tank immediately using the stairs

Hot Tub Rules

1. Users must be at least 14 years of age
2. Please limit time in the hot tub to 15 minutes at a time with 15-minute breaks in between
3. Lifeguards may ask you to exit the hot tub if you are showing signs of distress or overheating.
4. Only 8 people in the hot tub at one time

Wrist Band Rules

Red Band - Child is less than 48" tall and cannot pass the swim test must stay on the frog side of the line.

No Band - Child is at least 48" tall and cannot pass the swim test must stay behind the lane line in the "family zone."

Yellow Band - Swim test required for those under age 14 to swim without an adult in the "swim zone."

- Test - Jump feet first into a depth of 5'. Surface and swim any front stroke to the lane line and back. Tread water for 30 seconds. Climb out without a ladder.

Green band - Swim test required for those under 14 to swim without an adult in the pool.

- Test - Jump feet first into a depth of 8'. Surface and swim front crawl, breast stroke or a combination to the opposite wall, turn and swim back to the red line at the 5' marker. Tread water for 60 seconds.

YMCA lifeguards have the authority to make decisions that supersede these rules to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all members and guests.

I have read and understand the YMCA pool rules and agree that I, and my guests, will abide by them. I understand that failure to follow these rules or any instructions given by any Butte YMCA lifeguards or other staff may result in the offending person being asked to leave the property and that no refunds will be given for guests asked to leave for failure to follow rules. I certify that I have received a copy of these rules.
